HEALTH EXAMINATION

A health examination is required by the State of Minnesota for all students attending the program. Please have a local doctor complete the health form and sign it in the appropriate place. Send this health record to the Y.O.U. office in Pasadena.

ACCIDENT POLICY

Every student of the Y.O.U. Summer Educational Program is required to complete the enclosed accident policy application. All we need is the applicant's name, residence address, beneficiary's name and address, the relationship of the beneficiary to the proposed insured, and the signature of the proposed insured. The application will be completed by Justice Life Insurance Company and a policy issued. Cost of the policy is covered in your application fees to attend camp.

TUITION

Payment by check is always acceptable, however, we have also set up a credit card payment plan that should benefit all of you and greatly cut down on the procedures at Headquarters.

Acceptance to SEP is complete upon receipt of full payment. The deadline date is May 15, 1977. Receipt of your check (full payment) or permission to

charge your credit card account recorded on the Billing Notice will complete conditions of acceptance to the program.

Make checks payable to Y.O.U. Summer Educational Program. Return the Billing Notice and payment or credit card information to our business office at 300 West Green Street, Pasadena, California 91123.

NOTE: If payment is not received by the deadline we cannot process your application.

GYMNASIUM

The fully equipped gymnasium built this year at Orr will make it possible to provide special training in basketball, volleyball, cheerleading and social recreation.
