




SUMMER EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM




The Campus





A BEAUTIFUL ENVIRONMENT uniquely set for learning opportunities.

Safety is stressed in every phase as students learn skillful marksmanship. The coordination and self-discipline achieved by proper use of the bow and arrow or rifle gives a balanced sense of confidence.



Water Sports

Swimming is an important part of the activities at Y.O.U. Summer Educational Program. A special emphasis is placed on developing strong, healthy, well-coordinated bodies. Also, each student is required to know how to swim before he can water ski or go on a canoe trip. Energetic games of water polo along with swimming races help to balance out the instructional periods in this phase of the program.

The campus is a city in itself. All the services are here: excellent food, postal service, a fully equipped gymnasium, a Student Store, an Infirmary, Security Patrol, transportation to and from the campus. 


Water Skiing



Even beginning canoeists and campers experience the thrill of living in this wilderness environment and yet can be reached in minutes by motorboat from the campus.




Recreation, dancing, barbecue & Y.O.U.
